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Financial Sanctions Notice

ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaida Organisations

Introduction

1. Council Regulation (EC) 881/2002 ("the Regulation") imposing financial sanctions with regard to the ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaida organisations has been amended.

Notice summary (Full details are provided in the Annex to this Notice)

- 2. The following entries have been amended and are still subject to an asset freeze:
 - JAMAAH ANSHARUT DAULAH (Group ID: 13830)
 - ISLAMIC STATE IN IRAQ AND THE LEVANT LIBYA (Group ID: 13831)
 - ISLAMIC STATE IN IRAQ AND THE LEVANT YEMEN (Group ID: 13832)

What you must do

- 3. You must:
 - i. check whether you maintain any accounts or hold any funds or economic resources for the persons set out in the Annex to this Notice;

- ii. freeze such accounts, and other funds or economic resources;
- iii. refrain from dealing with the funds or assets or making them available (directly or indirectly) to such persons unless licensed by the Governor;
- iv. report any findings to the FRA at <u>financialsanctions@gov.ky</u>, together with any additional information that would facilitate compliance with the Regulation;
- v. provide any information concerning the frozen assets of designated persons to the FRA at financialsanctions@gov.ky by completing and submitting a Compliance Reporting Form (CRF). Information reported to FRA may be passed on to other regulatory authorities or law enforcement.
- 4. Where a relevant institution has <u>already reported</u> details of accounts, other funds or economic resources held frozen for designated persons, <u>they are not required to report these details again</u>.
- 5. Failure to comply with financial sanctions legislation or to seek to circumvent its provisions is a criminal offence.

Legislative Details

- 6. On 11 March 2020 Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2020/184 ("the Amending Regulation") was published in the Official Journal of the European Union (O.J. L 74, 11.3.2020, p.20) by the European Commission.
- 7. The Amending Regulation amended Annex I to the Regulation with effect from 11 March 2020.
- 8. The Amending Regulation reflects the decisions made on 4 March 2020 by the United Nations Security Council (UNSC) Committee established pursuant to Resolutions 1267 (1999), 1988 (2011) and 2253 (2015) to add 3 entities to the UN ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaida Organisations list.
- 9. In accordance with the United Nations and European Union Financial Sanctions (Linking) Regulations 2017 made under the Policing and Crime Act 2017, the UK enacted this decision on 05 March 2020 and issued Notice 'HM Treasury notice, 05/03/2020, ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaida Organisations'. This EU Amending Notice supersedes that Notice.
